

BOK CHOY SALAD

This salad is made of three parts: veggie mixture, crunchies and dressing.

Keep all 3 parts separate until ready to serve. You don't want the crunchies to get soft & soggy.

Veggie mixture:

- 2 Large heads of Bok Choy – chopped
- 2 bunches of scallion – chopped
- Toss together and put into a baggie and refrigerate

Crunchies

- ½ to ¾ cup sesame seeds
- 8 oz sliced almonds
- 4 pkgs Ramen noodle – broken up (discard seasoning pkg)
- 1 stick butter
- 4 tbsp sugar

In medium heat, melt butter in a pan, add sugar, stir until sugar is dissolved.

Add Ramen noodles, as the noodles brown, add almond slivers, and last, sesame seeds.

Keep tossing until mixture becomes toasty brown.

Let mixture cool off and place in a container.

Dressing

- 1 cup olive oil or salad oil
- ½ cup sugar
- ¼ cup red wine vinegar
- 2 tbsp balsamic vinegar
- 2 tbsp soy sauce

Place all ingredients in a jar and shake well till sugar is fully dissolved

Refrigerate until ready to use

Finally combine all three parts just before serving


